Rendino's celebrates 40 years

In 1975 a young and hard working Patty Rendino opened Rendino's Pizza. Although many things have changed in the past 40 years, Patty is still hard at work, making the best Italian carry-out food.

The menu has changed slightly, but quality pizza, subs, pasta and meatballs have always been available. Two new additions are the antipasto and homemade Italian dressing. The antipasto is stacked high with cold cuts and provolone covering

a bed of fresh chopped lettuces and sprinkled with pepperoncini, red onions, tomatoes and black olives. It is served with garlic rolls or homemade garlic bread and a homemade Italian dressing that is so delicious you'll want to take an extra bottle home.

There are a myriad of reasons that Rendino's has been recognized as the best around. It's the combination of its stone hearth, freshly made dough, homemade sauce, high quality toppings, and

lots of them. Rendino's is one of the only local pizzerias that still hand slices pepperoni and uses premium Wisconsin 100 percent provolone cheese.

The sub sandwiches include homemade sauce and meatballs, high quality sausages and cold cuts served hot and loaded with premium Wisconsin cheese. Patty is quick to give credit to co-worker, Mary Cantor, for producing the delicious subs, antipastos and signature Italian dressing which are made

fresh daily. They've worked together for over six years, and Patty considers her "an honorary Rendino."

Patty was heavily influenced by watching how hard her parents Vincent and Joann worked. Vincent as a distinguished employee of the Akron Transit Authority and Joann as a business-woman and entrepreneur opening Gino's Pizza in 1960. In 1967 Joann's sister, Adele Zimbardi, joined as a co-owner of Gino's. In 1970, Patty's uncle, Joe Lenze, and wife Marie opened Marie's Pizza in Wadsworth. He inspires Patty to this day with his strong work ethic. Patty watched as he built the restaurant from the ground up.

In the beginning, Patty worked over 80 hours a week, only closing her shop on Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas. She still maintains a busy schedule to provide high quality food to her loyal customers. Rendino's Pizza has an extensive menu which can be viewed online at www.rendinospizza.com.
